CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

BEGINNERS IMPROV A creative challenge for the newbie Improviser. Learn how to 'Find the Funny', how to use Improv as a rehearsal tool and to enhance auditions. Heighten and explore your boundless imagination using your natural gifts! (Ages: ADULTS)

STAGE ACTING 101 Learn everything from stage directions, to Improv, to acting with accents, to comedy, to performance as a business. Use acting games to unleash your creativity!
